Last year we made the transition to using the OCM system in Learn for submission and marking of summative written assignments. We experienced some technical glitches in the past which made it difficult for markers to use the system successfully and this resulted in different people using different methods to overcome some of these issues. We were pleased that the technical glitches were resolved for this most recent submission and the focus now will be to ensure that all markers provide annotations on the learners' scripts and on the feedback form (in OCM) in a more standardised way across all modules.

Course Director Response:

The External Examiner notified us of one internal marker whose annotations on learners' exams scripts was significantly different in style to other markers and not of the same quality as the other markers. Annotations were present, but it was difficult to determine how and where this particular marker awarded points and it was not obvious how they reached their overall mark for each of the learners' answers to each of the questions. This was raised and discussed at the exam board and agreed that the marker needs to be given feedback and further training on annotation of exam scripts and summative written assignments.
