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9.	Consequence of Failure:	
9.1.	A student who fails to complete a 30 weeks full-time placement in a workplace(s) relevant to their course will be allowed to either:	
	Defer their subsequent studies for a year to complete their 30 weeks full-time in placement OR	
	Complete the required 30 weeks full-time at a later date, for example during holidays, or after completing the subsequent year OR	
	Exit the placement year scheme and recommence studies at the start of the subsequent year	
9.2.	A student who fails the placement year summative assessment shall be given the opportunity to resubmit. The student will be required to resubmit their Project Report and Reflective Oral Presentation.	
	The overall mark obtained at the second attempt will be no greater than 40%.	
9.3.	A student who fails after a second attempt will be required to withdraw from the Certificate in Work-based Learning and Research. They have a right of appeal as described in the College Regulations.
