## 7.3 Method 1 Calculation

Honours will be awarded to students who meet the following criteria:

- (i) A student who has undertaken the 5 year programme, or entered via the Gateway programme, gaining 16.5 (37.5%) or more honours points shall be eligible for honours, provided that the criteria described in (iii) and (iv) are fulfilled.
- (ii) A student who has undertaken the Graduate Entry or Combined Degree programmes, gaining 10.5 (37.5%) or more honours points shall be eligible for honours, provided that the criteria described in (iii) and (iv) are fulfilled.
- (iii) At least 10 points must be obtained from the Finals BVetMed Examinations.
- (iv) The student has not been required to defer Finals Part 1 as a result of earlier failure.

## 7.4 Method 2 Calculation

Honours will be awarded to students who meet the following criteria:

- (i) A student who has undertaken the 5 year programme, or entered via the Gateway programme, gaining 16.8 (37.5%) or more honours points shall be eligible for honours, provided that the criteria described in (iii) and (iv) are fulfilled.
- (ii) A student who has undertaken the Graduate Entry or Combined Degree programmes, gaining 10.5 (37.5%) or more honours points shall be eligible for honours, provided that the criteria described in (iii) and (iv) are fulfilled.
- (iii) At least 10 points must be obtained from the Finals BVetMed Examinations.
- (iv) The student has not been required to defer Finals Part 1 as a result of earlier failure.
