

COMPOSITION OF APPOINTMENTS COMMITTEES FOR ACADEMIC POSTS

Senior Lecturer Appointments Committees

- i) The Principal or nominee
- ii) The Vice-Principal for Teaching or nominee
- iii) The Vice-Principal for Research or nominee
- iv) The Head of Department in which the appointment is proposed
- v) Normally, one other member of that Department (being a Professor, Reader or Senior Lecturer) to be nominated by the Principal, in consultation with the Head of Department
- vi) An external expert to be appointed by the Principal in consultation with the Head of Department

Lecturer Appointments Committees

The composition is as for Senior Lecturer Appointments Committees, excepting that under point (v) the committee member may, in exceptional circumstances, be a lecturer.

The above composition was approved by the Academic Board on 18 February 1998.
