
Chihuahuas Small dogs but big popularity



CONCLUSIONS

- Chihuahuas have unique behaviours and needs that prospective owners should consider in advance. Owners should avoid purchasing these puppies on impulse or as accessories.
- Owners should be prepared for the costs of surgery for common problems in Chihuahuas such as dental disease, retained baby teeth, sliding kneecap and undescended testicle.
- Dental disease and obesity are particularly common problems in Chihuahuas. which owners can take measures to help prevent. The study included 11,647 Chihuahuas from 336,865 dogs across the UK.
