our surgical facilities

We aim to operate to the highest standards of care and sterility. As a University we are improving and updating all the time.

We will **admit** from 8am or the night before if this is more convenient to you.

All animals are **thoroughly checked** prior to anaesthetising. **Pre op bloods** are discussed and performed if warranted. **Pain relief is given as standard to all surgical cases.** The latest and safest anaesthetics are chosen with your pet's individual needs in mind.

The Operating Suite is a closed area and contains:

- a prep room
- orthopaedic theatre
- soft tissue theatre
- neutering theatre
- dental suite

A porous load **autoclave** sterilises equipment to human standard.

All theatre staff change into scrub suits. All surgeons are gowned, gloved and masked.

Anaesthetics are monitored by fully qualified, experienced Veterinary Nurses using the best in equipment:

- ECG
- capnograph
- pulse oximeter
- heated tables
- drip pumps
- diathermy
- suction
- endoscopy
- **advanced dental equipment**-for descaling, polishing and extractions



neuter clinic

The hospital neutered over 1500 animals last year.

Subsidised neutering is available for OAPs, students, persons in receipt of Government benefits and in some cases low incomes.

As well as dogs and cats we routinely neuter rabbits, guinea-pigs and ferrets.

• BY CAR

There is pay and display along Royal College Street 80p for 30 mins 8.30 am to 6.30pm weekdays

• ON FOOT

From Camden High Street-turn Into Plender Street (Belushi's Bar is on the corner)
