## Vestibular Disease in dogs: "Old Dog Syndrome"

Vestibular disease (often known as "old dog syndrome") more commonly affects aging dogs and results in loss of balance.


Which breeds are most at risk?


What were the clinical outcomes?
41.8\% of cases improved after an average of 4 days
18.3\% of cases were hospitalised for treatment
$3.6 \%$ of cases were referred to speciality centres
$9.0 \%$ of cases still had a head tilt after one month
$11.6 \%$ of cases were euthanased on first veterinary presentation
CONCLUSIONS:

these breeds should these breeds should
be alert for typical signs as their dog ages.

Although vestibular disease may look very alarming, the outcomes may not be as bad as first feared. Four in ten cases were much improved after 4 days on average.
