


What is lymphoma?

Lymphoma is a cancer of lymphocytes, a type of white blood cell, and is


one of the most common cancers in cats.








## What factors are associated with lymphoma diagnosis?



Breed and environmental exposures studied were not found to influence the risk of lymphoma diagnosis.

#### **CONCLUSIONS:**



Increased diagnosis in insured cats suggests strong welfare gains for insured cats.
