

TIMETABLES

The curriculum of The Royal Veterinary College is governed by the Academic Board, following recommendations made by the Teaching Committee. The following rules have been approved by the Academic Board:

Lectures:

- shall terminate no more than 45 minutes after the scheduled start time
- shall start on time whether or not the whole group is in attendance at the scheduled start time
- there shall be no more than 3 timetabled lectures in any half-day
- there shall be no more than 2 consecutive lectures unless there is a minimum of a half-hour break

It is intended that there shall be no more than 15 lectures per week, which in general, means that there shall be no more than 4 lectures in any one day. Timetabled seminar, practical and directed learning time shall not be used for lectures.

The BVetMed Clinical Timetable is based on a rolling programme incorporating all rotations. It commences with the beginning of the Third year and is completed after the Final Examinations. Any holiday allowance is built into the schedule or into the rotations.
