

BVD CONTROL PROGRAMME FOR ENGLAND

Control of BVD has been identified by the Cattle Health and Welfare Group (CHAWG), as a priority for the English cattle industry. With a new DEFRA RDPE funding stream now available to help support knowledge and skills training for the next fifteen months in the control of BVD, we are looking for vets in England to join our new BVD programme and help to control this disease.

Technical materials are currently being prepared by Professor Joe Brownlie and his team at the RVC. These will be delivered to vets through CPD workshops in February to April 2013. These workshops will also outline materials and resources to use subsequently with farmers, along with details of how cross sector industry collaboration is expected to provide underpinning support.
