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*Evidence Based Veterinary Education (EVBE)

EBVE is a bridging module only and is a requirement for PG Diploma students who plan to progress to the MSc.

The module is designed to provide basic research methods support and is aimed at

- students who do not have prior Level 7 research experience
- students whose Bachelor degree did NOT include a research project.

Most students who hold a Bachelor degree or higher will be exempt from this requirement.

EBVE is taught annually, at the same time as the final PG Diploma module for that academic year. You may choose to study EBVE in either year 1 or year 2 of your PG Diploma studies but may only study one module at any one time.
