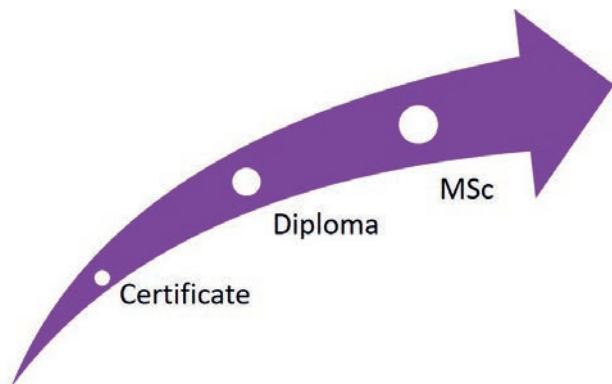

The MSc in Veterinary Education programme will enable you to develop your performance as an educator and to provide an enhanced learning experience to anyone you teach or train. You can study as a distance learner or face-to-face by attending classes at the Hawkshead campus in Hertfordshire or by using a combination of the two delivery modes.

Postgraduate Diploma in Veterinary Education

This component comprises four modules of 15 credits each, chosen from:

- Small group teaching
- Teaching the basic sciences in a clinical context
