
French Bulldogs Soaring UK popularity





- This study gives evidence on the rapidly rising popularity of French Bulldogs, which has been associated with welfare issues including mass puppy breeding and importation from long distances.
- The study findings provide owners and vets with information on common issues to expect and monitor for in French Bulldogs.
- The findings may assist potential owners to decide whether a French Bulldog is the right breed for them and encourage sourcing of puppies from responsible breeders.
